Commander MARSHALL B. BRISBOIS was born September 12, 1933 in Peabody, Massachusetts. He graduated from the University of Illinois in 1955, entered Officer Candidate School in September of 1955, and was commissioned an Ensign in January 1956. Commander Brisbois' first duty assignment was on board USS FORTIFY (MOS-446) where he served as Operations Officer. His subsequent sea duty assignments include tours as Combat Information Center Officer, USS LEONARD F. MASON (DD-852); Operations Officer, USS McMORRIS (DE-1036); Commanding Officer, USS SUMMIT COUNTY (LST-1146); Executive Officer, USS COONTZ (DLG-9). His shore duty includes tours as Aide to the Deputy Naval Inspector General, Washington, D.C.; Executive Department, U.S. Naval

Academy, Annapolis, Maryland; Commander Task Group 116.1 and Commander Task Group 116.3, Republic of Vietnam. Commander BRISBOIS graduated from the Army Command and General Staff College, Fort Leavenworth, Kansas, in June 1968.

Commander BRISBOIS has been awarded the Legion of Merit with Combat "V", the Bronze Star Medal with Combat "V", the Air Medal, the Combat Action Ribbon, the Republic of Vietnam Cross of Gallantry with Gold Star and Silver Star, and the Republic of Vietnam Staff Medal (First Class).

Commander BRISBOIS assumed command of USS TOWERS (DDG-9) on August 27, 1971.

Lieutenant Commander William H. Levings, III was born August 6, 1940 in Los Angeles, California. He graduated from the United States Naval Academy, and was commissioned an Ensign in June 1962.

Lieutenant Commander Levings' first duty assignment was on board USS RICHARD S. EDWARDS (DD-950) where he served as Main Propulsion Assistant. He later served in the billets of Damage Control Assistant and Engineering Officer.

His shore duty includes tours as instructor and company officer at the U.S. Naval Academy. He received his Master of Science degree (Meteorology) from the Naval Postgraduate School, Monterey, California in June 1968.

Lieutenant Commander Levings' decorations include the Navy Expeditionary Medal (Cuba), Armed Forces Expeditionary Medal, Republic of Vietnam Campaign Medal, and the National Defense Medal.

Lieutenant Commander Levings became the Executive Officer of USS TOWERS (DDG-9) on September 30, 1971.
